

# **BUCKETS FOR JESUS NEWSLETTER - JUNE 2023**



Dear family, friends and loved ones,

We pray that all is well with you and your loved ones. It has been a while since we last published a newsletter as Buckets For Jesus was impacted heavily by the Covid-19 Pandemic.

We were on mission in Manila in early when we first heard about the beginnings of the Coronavirus, and little did we know that it would throw the whole world into chaos, resulting in disruptions to our livelihoods, separation from families and so much uncertainties.

Buckets For Jesus have had to put their ministry days on hold during the lockdowns, and we were unable to travel to the Philippines due to border restrictions. Our mission partners over there were also unable to do any outreaches due to covid restrictions.

As lockdowns eased, we resumed our Saturday ministry days at our now former premises along Cowle Street, which we had to give up due to the end of the lease. This resulted in the final ever Container For Jesus departing from Perth, as we shipped over whatever could not be sold in the op shop. However, the pandemic made customs regulations much more complicated trying to eventually clear this container as it arrived in the Philippines.

The pandemic could not bring our missions to a halt despite us not being able to be physically present in the Philippines, as lo and behold, we were blessed with a new BFJ base in Rivervale which has become like a second home for us. Since October 2020, our missions have continued locally here in Perth as this base is where our ministry days take place, donations are packed and sorted and our Boutique Op Shop attracting numerous walk in visitors who have supported our cause.

As we prayed about how we were going to send donations in kind to the Philippines, we were led to J Cordon Express. This company which provides customers with Door to Door Balikbayan Boxes to the Philippines found out about our cause and even offered us discounts for our charity. We found this as a great opportunity to continue our missions, as we can send the boxes Door to Door directly to all our mission partners all over the Philippines and even opened the doors to send the Schoolbags For Jesus to bless needy children in regions we've never physically been to before.

In this Newsletter, you will read about how we made our presence felt during some of the outreaches that took place during the Pandemic and how the Holy Spirit has kept the missions going. We praise God and cannot thank you enough for your continued prayers and support in cash and kind to keep Buckets For Jesus going.






#### BFJ Book

The annual Schoolbags For Jesus campaign is mainly based here at the BFJ base, where all the contents are put into the bags, quality checked and then packed into the Balikbayan boxes to send to various regions of the Philippines. Various groups of volunteers are rostered on Saturdays to help pack the Schoolbags. Please contact us if you're interested.

The centrepiece of this base is the Boutique Op Shop, which has attracted numerous patrons who found about the sales via advertising on social media as well as the BFJ banner displayed by the main road. The The Murano jewellries have been very popular for Christmas and birthday presents, while household items, mens and womens' clothing have been selling at a good rate. # BUCKETFUL OF BLESSINGS FOR MARGINALISED FILIPINOS

BFJ IS short for Buckets for Jesus, a not-for-profit organisation whose mission is to help uplift the plight of the poorest of the poor in the Philippines.

I had the pleasure of interviewing Ruby Soh, the founder of Buckets for Jesus. She is one of the Filipinos who serve genuinely out of the goodness of her heart.

BFJ started after Ruby received a vision one morning in 2009 where she saw a sea of buckets filled with basic necessities like food, clothes, Bibles and rosaries and was told to take them to the poorest of the poor in the Philippines for a start and to the ends of the earth.

Over the years, Ruby considers their first mission as the most challenging which was a journey to the unknown and they feared for their safety as they were instructed to go the slums and help the poor.

But that's when they also learned the most valuable lesson when doing God's work or mission as 'He will go ahead of us and make the path straight'. God has intervened whenever a miracle is needed and these were documented in their book. Ruby shares, "The Word given to us was from Isaiah 41:10 'Do not be afraid..."

They have limited copies left of the first edition of BFJ's book, for which they are appealing support to print the second edition. The book can be purchased from BFJ base (39b Great Eastern Hwy, Rivervale WA 6103) or by email bucketsforjesus@gmail.com.

After 13 years of operation, their goal is to reach out to more countries apart from the Philippines, and explore Vietnam and China. They also hope to do missions in Kenya and India in the near future.

They also plan to replicate the Yolanda Village housing for disaster victims in Bogo, Cebu under the "Adopt A Family" appeal and build another village for another 100 homes in Negros Oriental.

They have been operating based on God's provision for 13 years through the kind response of people who have faith to help their mission work. Anyone can help by prayers, financial support or by volunteering.

Finally, Ruby would like to say to the generation of today, "Be the change. If you wish to change the world, let it start with you."
